Business Advisory Forum – The Business Advisory Forum will meet four times per year, beginning Q4 2016, to review general curriculum development and specific development in each of the four primary business sectors which NMiTE serves. The Forum will seek to, inform course relevancy to industry, to evaluate the employability statistics of students/graduates and to inform the evolution of course materials to the industry sectors. The Forum will be chaired by the Chief Academic Officer and one session a year will be followed by dinner and a distinguished speaker.

Leadership Advisory Panel - The Leadership Advisory Panel will meet twice a year, beginning Q1 2017, to help inform the broad parameters of how the university engages with business, to review the business sectors which the university is serving, and to review impacts that the university is having in terms of its key measurements including employability and quality of graduates, industry uptake of graduates, and impact on industry sectors. The Panel will be chaired by the Chair of NMiTE's Trustees, and attended by the Founding CEO & President, Chief Academic Officer and Chief Student Experience & Placement Officer.
